Introduction

IMTA [International Montessori Training Academy] was founded to provide quality training in Montessori Method of education. Ryan International Montessori school serves as a training centre for the IMTA courses for teachers and students. Montessori Method is the only existing scientific method of education in pre-school level based on the physiology and psychology of children.

Montessori education was founded by Dr. Maria Montessori in the year 1907. Dr. Montessori was the first Italian woman to become a physician.

IMTA announces the teacher training programme in association with Montessorians United, Bangalore. The duration of the certificate course is 6 months with [two months internship]. The trainees who successfully complete the internship only will be awarded with the certificates



The Curriculum

The course is designed for the application of the Montessori method of education to Pre Primary children ageing from 2 to 6 years. The training for the Pre Primary course will consist of the following subjects:

1. Child Psychology
2. The theory of the Montessori Method.
3. Demonstration and explanation of the Montessori Apparatus.
4. Assignments.

Series of lectures on the subjects will be delivered from time to time by our experts.

Written work has to be submitted at regular intervals during the course as directed by the lectures. Candidates who do not submit their work within the specified time or whose work is not found satisfactory may be refused admission to the examination. Internal assessments of the students will be made periodically.

Technical Details

- a] Lectures : will be delivered in English
- b] Practical : The students will handle the materials and acquire the technique of presentation.
- c] Written Work : Assignments from each area.

Eligibility

- ▶ Students Who have completed their plus two or equivalent examination or those who have completed their degree course in any subject are eligible for admission.
- ▶ People who enjoy working with children and are above 18 years old can also become a Montessori trained teacher.
- ▶ Working Teachers in KG or Primary classes.
- ▶ Parents who really want to know the system in an order to help their children, enhance their potential to the maximum there by developing their overall personality.
- ▶ Educators and school management representatives who wish to start Montessori schools



Attendance

Students who wish to qualify must observe punctuality in attending lectures and practical classes. A 10 minutes grace time will be given to all students on their first day. A student must have at least 90% attendance to be eligible to appear for the examination. However, absence due to illness or valid personal reasons will be considered, if the same has been informed to the Director before hand in writing with supporting documents. Leave of absence not intimated or unauthorized will be treated as discontinuation from the course.

Examination

The examination consists of two part- **Theory and Practical.**

The theoretical part consists of:

- ▶ Child Psychology
- ▶ The theory of Montessori Method

The Practical Part:

- ▶ Demonstration of Montessori Apparatus.
- ▶ Assignments.

The dates allotted to each candidate for their practical examinations cannot be altered under any circumstances. Candidates must pass in all subjects in the theoretical part and in the practical part. Only those who fail in at the most two subjects each will be granted permission to appear for the re-examination. A candidate who fails in there-examination will have to under go a full course of training again.

- Punctual Completion and submission of all assignments called for in the course of the year.
- Completion of required hours of School Teaching Practice.
- Completion of required hours of School Observation.
- Completion of required hours of supervised practice.
