## POINTS TO PONDER

- Children are expected to reach school by 08.45 am (Payangadi by 08.55 am). **The school gate will close sharp by 08:50 am (Payangadi by 09:00 am)** and thereafter no child shall be allowed in. This is of special importance for the safety of children.
- Since the medium of instruction is English, students should be helped to follow their work easily and intelligently by certain amount of conversation in English at home.
- To ensure better performance in class, it is strictly recommended that the ward is sent to the school regularly.
- Pupil may not attend school after absence even for half day unless the leave record in the log book is filled in by the parent.
- Parents of children taking leave for more than three consecutive days will have to meet the Grade mentor with a leave letter addressed to the Vice Principal. This is to help your ward complete his/her missed work. No leave will be granted on assessment days. (Unit tests / Examinations) except on medical grounds.
- Parents are to ensure that their ward is dressed as per the uniform guidelines prescribed. Any deviation from the same shall not be entertained.
- Refrain from remarks which undermine the position of the school and the teachers in the presence of the child.
- No child suffering from contagious or infectious disease will be allowed to attend the school.
- Identity Card must be worn daily.
- Parents are requested not to make any social engagements or medical appointments during school hours. To ensure better discipline parents are requested not to send their children to school on days when they have such appointments.

- No child will be permitted for an early departure until & unless on an emergency.
- Engaging in conversation with mentors / teachers during working hours is strongly discouraged. Should there be any discussion, you may fix prior appointment.
- Transport facilities over a reasonable distance are available for certain areas. The use of school transport is not a right and the school does not offer the same as a commitment. Parents not satisfied with school transport can make their own arrangements. Any bus route can be cancelled if it is found to be in convenient and uneconomical to the school.
- Parents are recommended to keep the television and other entertainment devices switched off during the study hours at home.
- Any changes in address and phone number should be reported to the school office through writing.
- You may communicate with mentors/coordinators through Teachmint or WhatsApp related to any of your child's problems. Parents are most welcome to approach the Vice principal / Admin. Director / Chairman with their constructive suggestions during the visiting hours with prior appointment.
- Parents are expected to maintain a very high order of discipline.
- The school reserves its right to request parents to withdraw their children from school if the parent behaves indecently.
- During the academic session 2024-25 a few Saturdays other than 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturdays will be working for which prior intimation will be given.

# SCHOOL TRANSPORT RULES

1. Transport facilities over a reasonable distance are available to certain areas. The use of School Transport is not a right and the school does not offer the same as a commitment. Parents not satisfied with school transport can make their own arrangements. Any bus route can be cancelled if it is found to be inconvenient and uneconomical to the school.

Children using school transport shall not be allowed to use any alternate mode of transport (even with their parents) unless, until, on an emergency

**Verbal communication through telephone, Bus drivers, support staffs, elder siblings or even through the child will not be accepted. This is in the best interest of the students.**

2. Students must **carry ID card** everyday. Those who fail to bring the same shall not be permitted to travel in the school bus.
3. **Parents of small children shall accompany the children and help the child to board the bus in the morning and wait to receive them in the evening.**
4. If the school bus fails to arrive on any day due to some unforeseen circumstances the students should come by other means. **No complaint will be entertained in such cases.**
5. **Students are expected to be at the bus stop before the arrival of the bus. The buses will not wait for late comers.**
6. Children should stay away from the main road until the bus arrives.
7. When the bus is in motion students must be seated. They should not have any part of their body put out of the bus.
8. Students will be held responsible for any damage to buses caused by their negligence or vandalism.
9. **No student is allowed to eat in the bus.**
10. Discarding of trash or food either inside or outside bus is not permitted.



11. Shrieking, shouting and unruly behavior are strictly prohibited. Courteous behavior is expected at all times.
12. The driver's attention must not be distracted for any reason.
13. Students must board and alight only at the point agreed upon. Change of bus route will be permitted only in the case of the transfer of residence. **Temporary change of bus stop will not be permitted.** Please refrain from calling the school office.
14. Parents are requested to educate the children in matters of road safety, and show them the right example when using the road or driving a vehicle.
15. The drivers are authorized to stop buses at the designated stop only, unless otherwise directed by the transport in charge.
16. The list of stops is prepared keeping in view the convenience and safety of commuters and is always subject to change.
17. Parents are requested not to enter the bus.
18. Parents should avoid picking up a dispute with the driver or bus monitor. Such disputes, work out to the students disadvantage. They should instead complain to the transport in charge. Students must obey the teacher traveling in buses and bus monitors appointed by the school. The bus monitor will ensure that small children and girls are seated in bus and the remaining seats are occupied by the senior boys.

### **Don't praise** Use the Language of Encouragement Instead

"Nice work", "You're the best", and "You are so smart" are examples of praise.

Encouragement is different and more powerful. It is honest and specific, it goes to the heart and not the head.

### SYMBOL OF FREEDOM, THE INDIAN FLAG

The National flag of India is in tricolour of deep saffron at the top, White in the middle and dark green at the bottom in equal proportions. The ratio of the width to the length of the flag is 2:3. In the centre of the white band, there is a wheel in navy blue to indicate the Dharma Chakra, the wheel of law in the Sarnath lion capital. Its diameter approximates the width of the white band and it has 24 equally spaced spokes. The saffron stands for courage, sacrifice and the spirit of renunciation; the white for purity and truth; the green for faith and fertility. The design of the National flag was adopted by Indian constituent assembly on 22nd July, 1947. Its use and display are regulated by code.
